'Purple Opal'

Blackberry 'Purple Opal' planted in a garden or a large pot on a balcony or terrace, in a sunny place, will allow you to enjoy **delicious, sweet and aromatic fruits** in **the first year** of cultivation. The fruits ripen from the end of July to the end of August.

Needs fertile soil, sunny position, and regular watering. Grows up to **80-90 cm** height. 'Purple Opal' is winter hardy to **-30°C**.

'Purple Opal' is **thornless** and bear fruit on one-year-old wood, which makes it pleasant and easy to maintain, also for novice gardeners.

BonBonBerry® Yummy

Raspberry BonBonBerry® Yummy is self-pollinating so **one plant is enough** to enjoy your own fruits. In the summer and autumn, you can pick as many **sweet and healthy** bonbons (pink raspberries) as you like (I collected them even in mid-October!). They appear on one-year-old wood.

It's **thornless**, compact and bushy. Grows up to **50 cm** height.

Needs fertile soil, sunny position, and regular watering. BonBonBerry® Yummy is winter hardy to **-30°C**.
